


European Rural Sustainability Gathering - 17-21 May 2017 – Greece

Dear colleagues and partners,

This year Forum Synergies' **European Rural Sustainability Gathering** will take place in **Karditsa** (region of Thessaly, Greece), from **17-21 May 2017**.

We will focus on social economy, cooperatives and grassroots initiatives in rural Greece.

The three-day gathering will be an opportunity to meet people with a spirit of cooperation and action for sustainable rural development from across Europe. We will visit **highlights of local sustainable initiatives and development action** in a region with strong civil society engagement.

Forum Synergies' rural sustainability gatherings are a lively exchange of practical knowledge and experiences between local actors, social organizations and policy makers from across Europe. During this three-day meetings we bring together people from all walks of life to learn on the spot from each other about sustainable practices in sustainable rural development, civil society activities and urgent topics as access to land, sustainable farming, economic activities and networking

This event will be co-organised with:

- **Karditsa Development Agency**, (AN.KA SA), is an agency of the local authorities acting as the local partnership in development issues. One of its activities is to support the formation of new collective schemes like cooperatives, business networks, non for profit organizations etc.
- **Iliosporoi Network**, One of the main topics this network is dealing with is related to alternative education, access to land and transition activities in Greece. As Greece tries to move out of a deep economic depression, one that has left 60 percent of young people without jobs we believe it is important to look at the signs of hope and success...
- **Peliti Seed Network**, Peliti is a movement preserving, exchanging and using traditional varieties, native farm animals, local food systems and circular economies and organising the first Olympic **seed festival in April this year**
- **Euracademy Association** is a non-profit European membership organisation established in 2003, with headquarters in Athens, Greece. Euracademy's vision is to promote capacity building in rural areas through lifelong learning and transfer of good practice and cooperation between different actors of rural development in the EU. The Association brings together rural development practitioners, universities, research institutions, policy makers and social partners from across the EU. Euracademy has conducted 15 annual summer academies on different aspects of rural development in 12 countries, including Greece, complemented by research and project work, and has published extensively.



We also wish to provide opportunities to **discuss Forum Synergies' current program and activities** such as: the future of youth in rural areas, local food chains and hygiene rules, territorial civic dialogue, as well as herbs and public health.

THE REGION

Plastiras Lake lies on Nevropolis plateau in Karditsa prefecture (25 km west of the city). It is 325 km far away from Athens and 250 km from Thessaloniki. It was formed in 1959, when the dam of the river Tavropos or Megdovas was completed.

The dam is an **impressive arched construction**, 200 meters long and 83 meters high. The surface of the lake covers an area of about 24 square km, the maximum depth reaching 60 meters and the round of the lake being approximately 100 km.



The lake took its name from the military officer Nikolaos Plastiras, as he was the one who had the idea of its formation.

Although the lake was constructed in order to solve the irrigation problems of the area, it induced the formation of a beautiful landscape, surrounded by special vegetation.

The area all around the lake is characterized by rich biodiversity and because of its great environmental value it has been added to the **Natura 2000** Protected Areas Network.

There are various **small villages** all around the lake with sufficient infrastructure to welcome and accommodate the visitors. Some of them are Moshato, Kerasia, Anthohori, Krioneri, KaliviaPezoulas, Neraida, Filakti, Neohori, Mouha, Kastania, Lampero – Agios Athanasios, Tsardaki and Karitsa.

DRAFT PROGRAMME

Wednesday 17th: Welcoming participants

- 1- **Welcome** from FS and hosts + overview of the program + logistic (30')

Thursday 18th: Setting the scene for sustainable development in times of crisis, the situation in Greece and Europe

- 2- **Who are the participants** - *answering questions of the moderator by moving in the room* (30')
- 3- **Goals of the workshop** by FS and our Greek partners + details on programme and logistic (30')
- 4- Sustainable development in times of crisis : **problems and dreams in the 4 corners of Europe** – *each participant is invited to present 2 photos ; facilitators stick them on a wall trying to identify families of problems and dreams* (90')
- 5- Sustainable development in times of crisis : **the specific situation in Greece**, in Karditsa region and in some other regions of Europe – *short speeches by our Greek partners and 3 other European regions ; each speaker would have to focus on one or several dimensions of the crisis, financial/economical, migratory, ecological, political* (60')
- 6- **Free walk on the spot** to open our sense of the place (60')
- 7- Analysis of the crisis: threats and opportunities, **raising questions for the next steps** – *working groups based on the main families identified in the morning; each working group sticks its questions on a wall to be seen by everybody at the end of the session during the break* (60')
- 8- **Market of initiatives** (90')
- 9- **European buffet**

Friday 19th: Discovering the rural reality in Lake Plastira and Karditsa region

The second day will focus on experiencing and exchanging on the local level. We will dive into Greek reality and start to draw lessons from what we have seen

The intention of the third day is to focus on what we intend to take home for

b) other regions

d) implications for the future work of Forum Synergies

- 14- **Synthesis of the 2 first days**: main points raised during the 1st day workshops and during the 2nd day plenary + **FS past and current activities** – *We ask 2X2 participants to prepare and present the synthesis and 2 BAT members to present FS activities + Presenting and choosing working group* (60')
- 15- **Creating possibilities for sustainable development in times of crisis** - Working groups on issues proposed by participants and organizers (inspired by open space process) ; each working group has to create possibilities for a, b, c, d (120')

Some topics could be identified in advance and new ones could be suggested by participants: e.g.
1/ Youth
2/ Ecosystem approach - economic grassroots activities
3/ etc.

- 16- **Market of tools for promoting cooperation or/ and personal engagement** – participants are invited to experiment a tool proposed by other participants; ex.: creativity methods, sociocracy, mindfulness meditation, tai chi... (60')
- 17- **Free walk on the spot** to be inspired by spring (60')
- 18- **Creating possibilities for sustainable development in times of crisis** – the findings of each working group are shared and discussed in plenary (30' for each level a, b, c, d)
- 19- **Creating possibilities of cooperation** – time open for the participants who are looking for partners for a specific project; ex.: FS on herbs, FS on Civic dialogue.
- 20- **Cultural evening**: music and dance
